David - The King

As a king, David allowed pride and position to cloud his heart and judgement. Read 2 Samuel 11.

God did not reject David as He did King Saul because:

1. David repented. Read 2 Samuel 12:1-25

- What sin do you need to repent today?
- Use Psalm 51 as a prayer of confession and repentance in your own life.

2. God forgave.

- Use Psalms 32 and 103 as a reminder and celebration of God's forgiveness.
- Consider how Jesus affirms God's forgiveness in his teaching. See Luke 15:11-31

What part did Nathan play in David's repentance?

- When has someone given you some hard truth about your own life? What did you do with their message?
- What kind of relationships are needed for this kind of accountability?
