Faith Church 2020 Advent Devotional Guidelines for Writers

- **Review** these guidelines and the invitation to write a devotion.
- **Pray** before you write anything or select your scripture/focus.
 - Ask God to reveal the focus of the devotional for you to share with the readers.
 - Continue to pray as you allow the Holy Spirit to guide your writing.
- Write in a clear, readable style. Think *snapshot* rather than *movie*. Stay focused on one central point or theme.
 - Present the big picture and then offer a practical application that challenges the reader to strengthen their relationship/commitment with God.
- Write personally and from your heart, sharing a "take-away" for the reader that might stick with them throughout the day.
 - It should have a positive theme of encouragement, hope, better relationships with God, the Church and/or the world, trusting God, a better life, etc.
 - Use inclusive pronouns like "we", "us", and "our" rather than "preachy" pronouns "you" or "your".
 - Feel free to use humor that is in good taste while avoiding theological dissertations.
- Use Scripture correctly. It's vital that you don't take Bible verses out of context and that each scripture has a clear and supportive connection to the devotional.
 - Be sure to include proper references and that the Bible verse is relevant to that particular devotion.
 - Make sure to indicate which translation of the Bible you are using for your Bible verses. You can use more than one translation if you choose.
- You may also want to include
 - a short title,
 - selected Bible verse(s)
 - the line or verse of the song you are referencing and/or
 - a prayer.

- **Previously published material** should not be submitted. Quotes must be referenced to the original source of the quote.
- Each devotional must fit on one side of a ½ sheet of 8.5" x 11" page using 1" margins and 12-point font. This equals approximately 35 lines or 350-400 words of text. Devotionals that are longer may be edited to accommodate this limit.
- Deadline to submit devotionals is Tuesday, September 15, 2020.

 - Use a word processor (MS Word, Google Docs, etc.), and send as an email attachment, or
 - Type your devotional into the body of an email.
